Grow your career as Medical Assistant. Banner Health is partnering with Front Range Community College (FRCC) to offer a 20-week paid Medical Assistant Apprenticeship.

Apprentices will learn clinical skills and administrative medical office procedures. The program curriculum follows the Medical Assisting Education Review Board standards and qualifies students to sit for the national Certified Clinical Medical Assistant exam through the National Health careers Association.

Earn While you Learn

- This paid program consists of 1 semester of coursework that includes on the job training at a Banner Clinic
- Student who successfully complete the program are eligible to transition to a permanent position on one of our clinic teams.
- As a Banner team member, students are eligible to receive full tuition support and certification fee reimbursement to help offset the costs associated with this program.
- Current Banner team members in Physician Patient Assistant positions are eligible for the Medical Assistant Apprenticeship.
