

Teen Volunteers in Health Care

Banner Teen Volunteers

- Volunteers need to be 16+ years of age.
- Volunteers need to pass a background test and the employee health screen including flu shot and some standard vaccinations. COVID vaccine is no longer a requirement.
- As of now, Northern Colorado Medical Center (NCMC) is the only hospital with a high school program.
- We usually require a commitment of 100 hours or six months but have worked with the high school students on this requirement as they often struggle to meet the minimum. Generally, we ask for a summertime commitment with limited missed shifts. For reference, onboarding a volunteer is about 70% of onboarding an actual employee.

Columbine Teen Volunteers

- Because we provide care for a vulnerable group, volunteers must be at least 16 years old, agree to a background screening (at no cost to the volunteer), and provide proof of a flu vaccine, October through May.
- COVID-19 vaccines are not required but recommended.
- A TB test may be required if a volunteer is working in an assisted living or skilled nursing facility.
